First Tracks

2009-2010 Ski Season!

Once again this season, owners at the Grand will be offered the privilege to get first tracks in Steamboat's Champagne Powder, just for being an owner at the Grand! Details are below so get your planks and boards waxed up and get ready for some early morning turns.

- First Tracks for Steamboat Grand Homeowners will be offered on Sunday, Wednesday, and Friday during the 2009-2010 ski season, beginning middle of December thru the middle of March depending on conditions.
- Space will be limited depending on the day and owner occupancy at the Steamboat Grand.
- **The First Tracks program is a privilege available to Owners of the Steamboat Grand. Owners will be allowed to participate in First Track 1 time per week plus one additional guest or family member can participate with the owner. (Ownership is dependent on the deed to the unit). Additional slots may be available; however an owner will not be able to book additional slots until 48 hours prior to their chosen participation day.**
- **There will be a \$10 fee for owner guests to participate in First Tracks.**
- Owners who are scheduled to stay in-house at the Steamboat Grand can book their First Tracks 14 days prior to the day they choose to participate in First Tracks. All other requests can be made 72 hours prior to their chosen participation day. Owners will need to contact Owner Services to book their requests. Requests will only be accepted during Owner Services business hours of Monday thru Friday 9am to 5pm.
- Due to safety issues the group **MUST** ski and ride together. Additional, we require that only advanced intermediate skiers/riders and above sign up for this program. This will allow the entire group to take advantage of a couple runs in that Champagne Powder® before the Gondola begins general loading.
 - Participants must stay with the group and follow the instructions of their guide. If a First Tracks participant does not follow these guidelines they will be subject to sanctions including ineligibility for future First Tracks and/or having their pass or lift ticket pulled. It is a risk not only for the participants of First Tracks, but also the First Tracks program if participants do not follow the guidelines.
 - Permitted Terrain for First Tracks are the following Trails: Westside, Rolex, High Noon, One O'clock, Two O'clock, Twilight, Three O'clock, and Kuus' Cruise.
 - Excluded Terrain are: Storm Peak Face, Sunset, Lights Out, Shadows, and Closets
- Participants will meet their guide at the First Tracks sign by the wagon in front of the gondola by **7:50 a.m. ready to ski or ride**. The first gondola will load at 8 a.m. sharp and the group will not wait for stragglers. Departure times are subject to change depending on the week.
- Any cancellations for First Tracks must be provided to Owner Services before Noon on the day prior to the First Tracks reservations. Cancellations for First Tracks on Sundays need to be done so by 5pm on the Friday prior. Failure to show up for a confirmed reservation will result in that owner's loss of First Tracks privileges.
